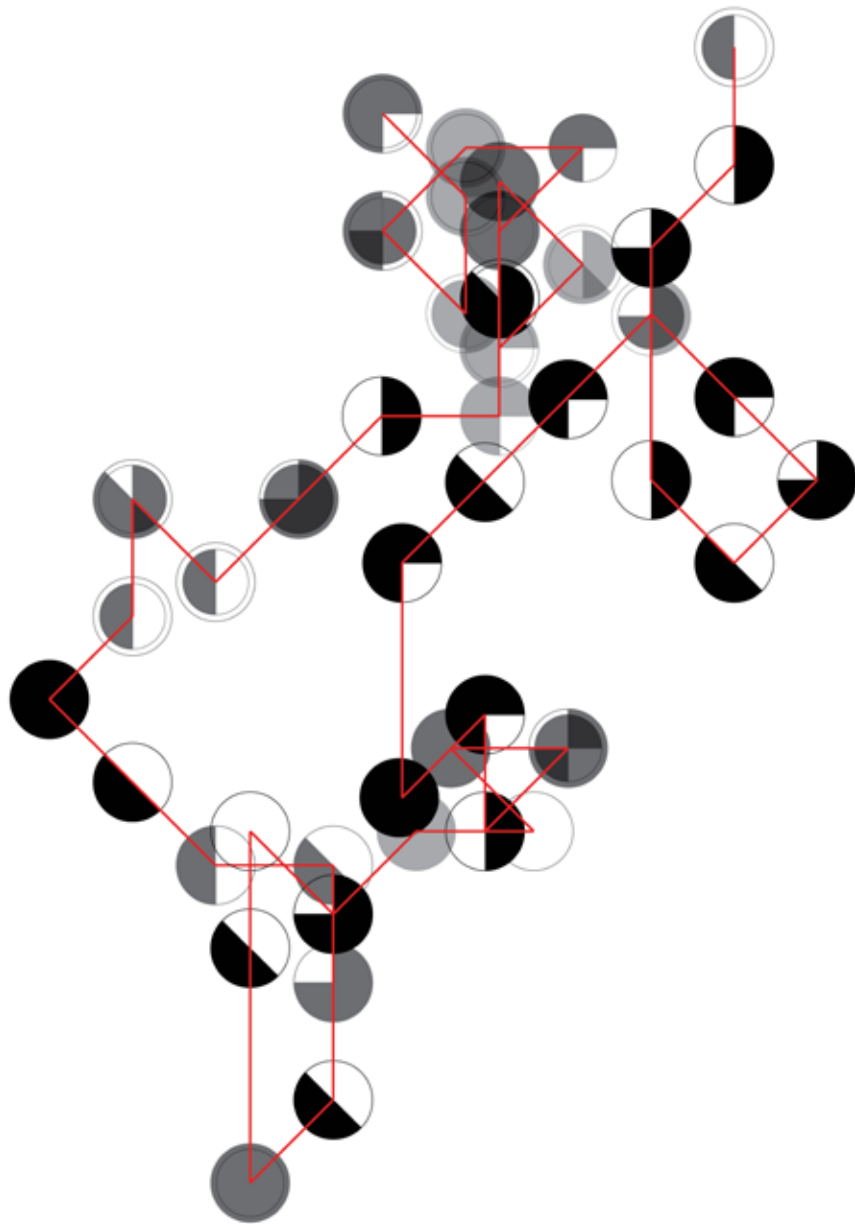
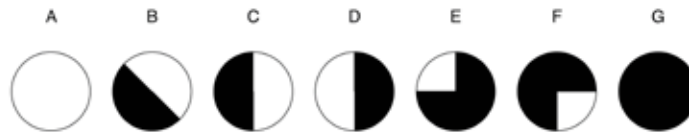

NOTES



DIRECTION (DETERMINED BY GENERATOR)



RULES

Every fifth note is placed northeast, northwest, southwest, and southeast (in that order) from the previous note

If any notes are sharp (#) they rotate -45 degrees

If any notes are natural (♮) they rotate 45 degrees

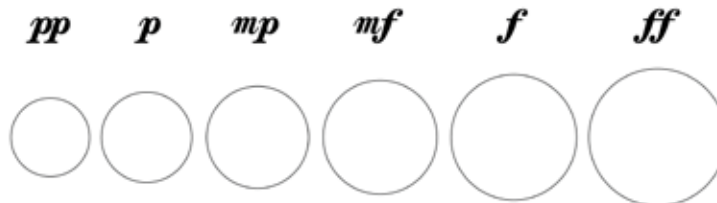
If any notes overlay or make other notes fade out completely in movement they go northeast

If any notes overlay even when they go up right then go two inches north

If a proceeding note touches a preceding note the note that occurs earlier fades by 30%; notes can only fade until they are of 10% opacity

If chords (two notes played simultaneously) occur the top note is within the other and both are at 70% opacity
